EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 04
Series of 2020

EXECUTIVE ORDER MANDATING ALL TOURIST BOAT OPERATORS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL JURISDICTION OF CULION TO REGISTER THEIR VESSELS.

WHEREAS, the State pursuant to RA 9593 declares tourism as an indispensable element of the national economy and an industry of national interest and importance;


WHEREAS, the need for the Recognize sustainable tourism development as integral to the national socioeconomic development efforts to improve the quality of life of the Filipino people, providing the appropriate attention and support for the growth of this industry;

WHEREAS, Culion potential as a tourist spot has been booming lately as seen on the arrival of more foreign tourist thus a need to establish accountability and control over this relatively new industry.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code Provides that the Municipal Mayor may Issue such executive orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances.

I MA. VIRGINIA N. DE VERA, Mayor of the Municipality of Culion, Province of Palawan by virtue of the Power vested in me by law do hereby issue this Executive Order;

1. All tourist boat operators operating within the Municipal Jurisdiction of Culion, are hereby mandated to register their vessel with the Municipal Tourism Office. The following are the requirements that be complied with in order for the vessel and operator be registered
 - i. Fully filled application form
 - ii. Certificate of Registration issued by the MARINA or Coast Guard regarding its sea worthiness
 - iii. Has undergone training for WASAR and BLS
 - iv. Tour guide License
 - v. Barangay Clearance
 - vi. MDRMM Clearance
2. All requirements should be complied to be able to be eligible for registration. In case the prospective registrant lacks a requirement except item ii, provisional registration shall be allowed provided it shall be complied within reasonable time. Failure to comply within reasonable time shall automatically suspend their registration.
3. This executive order shall take effect immediately.
