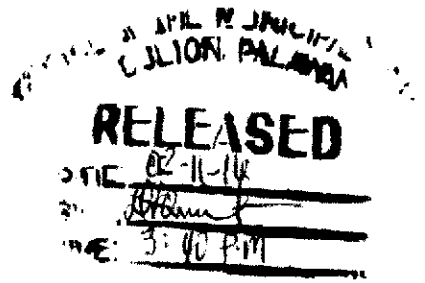
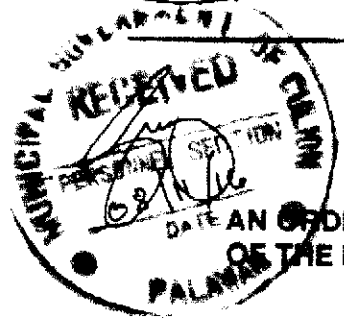

ORDER ADOPTING THE I-HEAL PROGRAM AS THE FLAGSHIP PROGRAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CULION, PROVIDING ITS PROGRAM MANAGERS AND DEFINING THEIR RESEPTIVE DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that "Every local government unit shall exercise the power expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, for efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the same Code;

WHEREAS, Section 444 (b) (4), the local chief executive shall ensure the delivery of basic services and the provision of adequate facilities as provided for under Section 17 of the same Code which empowers local government units in the exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, to effectively address the clamor of the populace in the provision of basic services particularly in public structures and facilities, health, education, agriculture and livelihood, it is necessary to adopt priority programs that would cater these immediate needs,

WHEREAS, said priority programs encapsulated under the I-HEAL Program was adopted and has been acknowledged by the Sangguniang Bayan by virtue of Resolution No. 2016-1056.

WHEREAS, the I-HEAL Program shall advance our collective desire towards a sustainable socio-economic development

NOW THEREFORE, I, MA. VIRGINIA N. DE VERA., Municipal Mayor of Culion, Palawan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order:

Section 1. DEFINITION. Each letter of the word **I-HEAL** shall refer to the first letter of the priority program of the Municipality, **I**-Infrastructure, **H**-Health, **E**-Education, **A**- Agriculture, and **L**-Livelihood. However, the municipality as a potential tourist destination due to its historical heritage, prestine beaches and vast natural resources, tourism promotion and environment protection is integrated in the said program

Section 2. COMPOSITION. To facilitate the implementation of the I HEAL Program, the following are hereby appointed as program managers, to wit:

Section 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The I-HEAL Program Managers shall perform the following duties and functions:

1. To develop a clear and detailed plan and ensure that a proposed program is feasible;
2. Formulate programs, projects and guidelines for the effective implementation of the program.
3. Implement the program and its activities in accordance with the target and goals;
4. Ensure that program activities comply with all relevant legislation, professional standards and operate within government policies and procedures;
5. Develop a program evaluation framework to assess the strengths of the program and to ensure that success or performance measures are achieved;
6. Coordinate with national agencies and private entities for funding or augmentation of funds for related programs, projects and activities;
7. Perform other functions as may be necessary to carry out effectively the objective of the program.

Section 4. FUNDING. A regular appropriation shall be charged against municipal funds.

Section 5. MEETINGS. I-HEAL Program Managers shall meet twice a month and as maybe determined by the General Manager.

Section 6. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
