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EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 31
Series of 2020

EXECUTIVE ORDER MANDATING THE PROCEDURE TO BE OBSERVED AND TO BE COMPLIED WITH FOR ALL LOCALLY STRANDED INDIVIDUALS WHO WOULD BE RETURNING TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF CULION AND ALL LOCALLY STRANDED INDIVIDUAL WHO WOULD BE EXITING THIS MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS, NTF Against Covid-19 order 2020-02 provides for the national guideline to be observed for cross border management of locally stranded individuals.

WHEREAS, upon the implementation of the enhanced community quarantine in several parts of the country, many are left stranded in active border control points and are unable to return to their respective residences.

WHEREAS, for a systematic and coordinated approach in facilitating the return of Locally Stranded Individuals to their respective residences.

WHEREAS, stringent measures must be placed in order to ensure that our Municipality would be compliant with the National and Provincial Policies that are in effect to ensure that we remain or minimize the risk of Covid infiltration.

WHEREAS, under the Police Power of the Local Government shall promote and ensure and support, among other things, promote health and safety.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code Provides that the Municipal Mayor may Issue such executive orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances.

I MA. VIRGINIA N. DE VERA, Mayor of the Municipality of Culion, Province of Palawan by virtue of the Power vested in me by law do hereby issue this Executive Order.

SECTION 1. The Following considered as Locally Stranded Individuals (LSI)

- a. Workers
- b. Students
- c. Tourist
- d. Individuals stranded while in transit
- e. Other individuals who are not residents of this municipality

All Barangay Captains are hereby called upon to disseminate this information to their respective jurisdiction, the barangay is hereby called upon to urge all Locally Stranded Individual in their areas to coordinate with the said barangay, the barangay shall hereby list all locally stranded individuals in their area and submit the said list to the Office of the Municipal Administrator.

SECTION 2. The Local Government of Culion shall hereby aid the said LSI such as transportation to the Municipality of Coron and shall aid as may be needed in order to ensure smooth transition to the said municipality.

SECTION 3. All returning LSI shall be received in this Municipality, if they possess the following

- f. Medical Clearance Certificate issued by the City/Municipal Health office of his origin, that he has complied with the requirement laid down by the National Guidelines.
- g. Travel Authority.
- h. All returnees shall be assessed by the Municipal Health office at the Port of Embarkation
- i. All Returnee shall be mandatorily be placed at the Municipal Isolation Facility for the 14 days mandatory isolation quarantine without exception.
- j. Those who would exhibit any of the symptoms upon arrival shall be placed in a different isolation facility and be subjected to established health protocols and procedures.
- k. In case any of the LSI exhibit any symptoms within the 14 day observation period, the Local Covid Task Force shall immediately report the name of the symptomatic LTI to the concerned Regional Task Force for coordinated response.

SECTION 4. All departing LSI from this Municipality are hereby advised to observe the following procedure

- l. Obtain a Medical Clearance from the Municipal Health Office, subject to the conditions that the LSI is neither a contact, suspect or probable or confirmed covid 19 cases.
- m. All LSI shall be placed for a 14 days mandatory quarantine prior to their departure on this Municipality in order to ensure that the LSI does not fall under the categories stated at the above enumeration.

SECTION 5. The MDRRMO head is hereby designated as the Facility Manager who shall be in charge in the management of the temporary quarantine facility that would be utilized in this endeavor.

SECTION 6. The Municipal Health Office is hereby ordered to issue the necessary guidelines in order to supplement this general order.

SECTION 7. This executive order shall take effect immediately and shall be enforced until it be revoked by a subsequent executive order.
