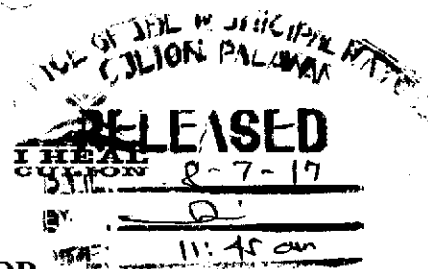

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 33
Series of 2017

**RECONSTITUTING THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB) AND
PRESCRIBING ITS DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, there is the declared policy of the Municipal Government of Culion to protect the interest and welfare of its citizenry by instituting measures equipped with checks and balances to avoid the abuse and misuse of power and authority by those entrusted with it, by putting in place a machinery that will discipline those erring police personnel within its territorial jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, The People's Law Enforcement Board of the Municipality of Culion shall be central receiving entity for any citizen's complaints against abusive and erring PNP enforcers and personnel;

WHEREAS, PLEB shall take cognizance or refer the complaint to the proper disciplinary or adjudicatory authority prescribed by the provisions of Republic Act 6975;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MA VIRGINIA N. DE VERA, Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following;

Section 1. RECONSTITUTION OF THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD. The PLEB is hereby reconstituted to implement the provisions of Republic Act 6975, as amended, in the promotion of discipline within the police personnel and justice for the people of the municipality of Culion, Palawan.

Section 2. COMPOSITION. The PLEB shall be composed of the following:

The chairman of the PLEB shall be elected from among its members.

Membership in the PLEB constitutes a public office, as such unless allowed by law or by the primary functions of his office, a public official or employee could not be appointed or designated to the Board.

Section 3. ISSUANCE OF ORDER TO PLEB MEMBERS. Upon issuance of a resolution by the Sangguniang Bayan formally organizing the Board, the Municipal Mayor shall issue the corresponding Order implementing the decision of the SB, LIGA and MPOC on their respective duties and responsibilities to the Culion PLEB.

Section 4. OATH OF OFFICE. Before assuming the duties of their office, the chairman and members of the PLEB shall take the oath of affirmation before an administering officer, which shall be filed with the office of the National Police Commission in the region where Culion Municipality is situated

Section 5. TERM OF OFFICE. The term of office of the PLEB members shall be for a period of two (2) years from assumption of office. Such member shall hold office until his successor has been chosen and qualified.

Section 6. COMPENSATION. Membership in the PLEB is a civic duty. However, PLEB members may be paid per diem as may be determined by the SB from LGU funds.

Section 7. QUORUM. The presence of majority of all the PLEB members shall constitute a quorum.

The Board shall determine by a majority vote of its members, whether or not the respondent officer or member of the PNP is culpable of the charge.

If for any reason, the chairman is unable to attend a meeting or is disqualified from participating therein, the members shall elect from among themselves a temporary chairman to perform the duties appurtenant thereto.

Section 8. DISQUALIFICATION BY REASON OF AFFINITY OR CONSANGUINITY. Any member of the PLEB who is related to the complainant or respondent by affinity or consanguinity within the fourth civil degree shall be disqualified from participating in the proceeding and the case shall be tried by the remaining members. Provided, that there is sufficient number to constitute the quorum.

In the event that the PLEB could not proceed with the hearing for lack of quorum, the MPOC shall appoint temporary member/s to try and decide the specific case only.

Section 9. POWERS AND DUTIES. The Culion PLEB shall have the power to hear and adjudicate all administrative complaints formally filed with, or referred to it, against any member of the PNP, and to impose the corresponding penalty.

In the exercise of its function, the Culion PLEB, acting through its chairman is empowered to administer oaths, summon witnesses, require the production of documents, records, books, or other things by a subpoena duces tecum and issue other processes as may be necessary.

Applying the provision of Article 152, Chapter IV, Title III, Book II of the revised Penal Code, the members of the Culion PLEB are considered persons in authority.


Section 10. SECRETARIAT. The secretariat shall be headed by the Municipal DILG Officer and the LGU shall provide the personnel for the necessary back staffing support.

Section 11. FUNDING. The operation expenses required by the Culion PLEB shall be incorporated in the Annual Executive Budget.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall supersede all previous Executive Orders issued to this effect.

Section 13. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
