EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 36,
Series of 2020



AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING A PUBLIC HEALTH SAFETY COMMITTEE WHICH WOULD ENSURE PUBLIC HEALTH SAFETY IN THIS MUNICIPALITY DUE TO THE RECENT POSITIVE RAPID TEST INCIDENT.

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, in this trying time we all have a social responsibility to observe and comply with;

WHEREAS, currently, there are three (3) patients in this municipality who were found positive of COVID-19 virus after having undergone rapid testing and waiting for the SWAB test result from Puerto Princesa City and are now in the quarantine facility of Culion;

WHEREAS, to enforce social order and discipline during this trying time and to protect the whole public;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code provides that the Municipal Mayor may issue such executive orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ma. Virginia N. De Vera, Mayor of the Municipality of Culion, Province of Palawan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby issue this Executive Order, as follows:

Section I – Composition:

1. Health Management and Testing for Locally Stranded Individuals –

a. Dr. Israel H. Zantua – Chairman

Coordinators – RHU personnel and Barangay Health Workers

- They shall recommend and coordinate with the CSGH for any concerns related to Health Status of LSIs;
- Initiate thermal gun scanning and cause health preventive measures prior rapid test;
- Monitor the health status of LSIs;
- Perform COVID-19 Rapid Testing to all LSIs under the Municipal Isolation unit/facility.

2. Public Information and Security -

a. Mr. Maxim F. Raymundo – Chairman

Coordinators – MSWD, ABC President and Philippine National Police

- Conduct public information and dissemination regarding update and protocols on COVID-19 within the municipality;
- Ensure that COVID-19 checkpoints are properly implemented, and all quarantine or isolation facilities are secured;
- Coordinate with barangays on the security of each community.

3. Facilities and Logistics –

a. Mr. Armando G. Lagrosa II, RN. – Chairman

Coordinators – Engr. Christie D. Fructuoso, Ms. Ma. Mirasol U. Pastrano

- Provide facilities, food subsistence and medical needs of patients while under quarantine;
- Prepare and equipment facilities
- Provide electrical and water source (drinking and other purposes)

4. LSI/APOR Mobilization –


a. Mr. Jubelle D. Cabatingan – Chairman

Coordinators – Engr. Philbert Mark Isabelo, and Philippine Coast Guard

- Conduct regular monitoring and coordination for incoming and outgoing LSIs/APOR;
- Coordinate transportation of incoming LSIs to different quarantine facilities.

This order takes immediately upon approval.
