DESIGNATION OF FOCAL PERSON ON CANCELLATION OR SUSPENSION OF CLASSES AND WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES DUE TO TYPHOON, FLOODING, OTHER WEATHER DISTURBANCES, AND CALAMITIES

WHEREAS, the President of the Republic of the Philippines has issued Executive Order No. 66, series of 2012, prescribing rules on the cancellation or suspension of classes and work in government offices due to typhoons, flooding, other weather disturbances and calamities which provides that in the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA, localized cancellation or suspension of classes and work in the government offices may be implemented by local chief executive, as chairman of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC);

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) directed all local chief executives to designate a focal person who will coordinate matters pertaining to the cancellation or suspension of classes and work during typhoons, flooding, other weather disturbances and calamities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MA. VIRGINIA N. DE VERA, Municipal Mayor of Culion, Palawan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the law do hereby order:

Section 1. Designation. MR. ARMANDO G. LAGROSA II, RN, *Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer – Designate*, is hereby designated as the Focal Person on the cancellation or suspension of classes and work in government offices due to typhoons, flooding, other weather disturbances and calamities in the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA.

Section 2. Functions.

1. For the Automatic Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Government Offices:

Ensure that the information is well-disseminated to all concerned officials of public and private elementary, secondary, and tertiary schools as well as of government offices.

2. For the Localized Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Government Offices in the Absence of Typhoon Signal Warnings from PAGASA:

Upon the decision of the Local Chief Executive, Chairman of Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, ensure that announcements are made not later than 4:30 A.M. of the day of the intended cancellation of classes and work, or not later than 11:00 A.M. for suspension of classes and work in the afternoon session, through diverse mass media, particularly radio and television, mobile phones, and other

technologies for communication within the community or locality.

3. For the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Government Offices during other weather disturbances and calamity.


Ensure that the announcements made by the Local Chief Executive, Chairman of Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, are well-disseminated in areas affected by disasters or calamities other than typhoons, such as, but not limited to floods, earthquakes, tsunami and conflagration, through all forms of mass media available under the circumstances.

4. As the Focal Person – Designate, make certain that you are accessible both in person and through telecommunications so as to guarantee non-disrupted flow of information.

Section 3. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
