MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2020-127

ORDINANCE CREATING THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL(MADAC) OF CULION, PALAWAN

WHEREAS, the proliferation illegal drugs ruin numerous lives of the people and destroys the very fabric of the community, the family and a hindrance to local development as well;

WHEREAS, the creation of an anti-drug abuse council at the municipal level is pursuant to the marching order of the president on the all-out war against illegal drugs the use of which is a serious threat to public health, welfare, and to national security and assures the continuity of the progress in the fight against prohibited drugs;

WHEREAS, R.A. 9165 known as the Comprehensive Drugs Act of 2002 emphasizes the important participation of local government units in safeguarding the citizenry from harmful effects of illegal drugs;

Premises considered, be it ordained by the 9th Sangguniang Bayan of Culion, Palawan in session duly assembled, THAT:

Section 1. This Ordinance shall be known as the "MADAC of Culion, Palawan creation ordinance".

Section 2. The council shall be composed of the following:

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- Chairman : Municipal Mayor
Vice-Chairman : Chief of the Municipal Police Station
- Members : Municipal Local Government Operations Officer
Municipal Trial Court Judge
Municipal Social Welfare & Development Officer
Municipal Health Officer
Municipal Public Information Officer
Municipal Probation and Parole Officer
Religious Sector Representative
At least two(2) NGO Representatives

Section 3. The functions of the MADAC shall be those provided in the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01 dated May 21, 2018 of the DILG and the Dangerous Drugs Board. In addition thereto, the council in proper coordination with the concerned national government agency counterparts, shall formulate programs necessary to achieve the goal of minimizing or totally eradicating illegal drugs at the barangay level leading to a drug free municipality.

Section 4. All punong barangays are required to submit an action plan and programs aimed at fighting and curbing the proliferation of illegal drugs in their respective area of jurisdiction.

Section 5. The Council is hereby given authority to penalize and sanction barangay officials who fail to comply with the provisions of this ordinance as follows, to wit:

- a. First Offense: Stern warning and reprimand
- b. Second Offense: Fine amounting to PhP 1,000.00
- c. Third Offense: Filing of disciplinary action before the sanggunian bayan for suspension

Section 6. A special fund which is named "Culion MADAC Trust Fund" is hereby created and maintained at the Land Bank of the Philippines-Coron Branch where fines collected for violating this ordinance shall be deposited. The said fund shall be exclusively utilized to promote the advocacy against drug addiction.

Section 7. Within thirty(30) days upon approval of this ordinance, the office of the mayor shall issue the necessary rules and regulations for the proper and effective implementation thereof.

Section 8 Separability Clause. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


Section 9. Repealing Clause. The provisions of existing ordinances, orders and regulations which are in conflict hercof, are hereby amended, modified, repealed and/or superseded accordingly.


Section 10. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval after three (3) consecutive weeks of posting at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in this local government unit.


